Many counsellors work in or are training for education or social services fields, or they just seem to "get it".

Counsellors play an important role, helping campers increase their confidence, try new things, stay safe, and most of all, have fun. I don't think it's just a job to them, they really care about these kids. I was very impressed with the amount of one-on-one time spent with Jonathan because I know his support needs are being met in an environment designed just for that. They have lots of communication with the parents. One counsellor sent me pictures of activities they did which was so great to see. Jonathan finds verbal communication challenging, and pictures allowed him to share his experiences with our family and continue to re-live some very exciting moments after returning home.
