or Dad nagging her. Even though Jana is very independent, we do check up on her often. But at Camp Easter Seal, everything is taken care of. We don't worry about her safety. In all the years Jana has gone, she has never called us and said she isn't having fun and wants to come home. If anything, she'd prefer us to leave her there for another week," laughs Shirley as Jana responds nodding her head with a big smile. "Well, it's only five days," chimes in Jana.

"COVID-19 has impacted everyone in different ways. It has been isolating for everyone but especially for individuals like Jana who are experiencing disability. Going without programs and services like Camp, it's a big loss and not just for campers but their families and caregivers. Not everyone is lucky enough to have a big support group or network. Jana is a very social person. She is on social media and she likes to send out text messages. Sometimes she'll do a Facebook live to speak her mind. But she has us, her family and friends who make sure she's doing okay," explains Shirley of the real impact the pandemic had on individuals experiencing disability.

For Jana, the social aspect of Camp Easter Seal is at the top of her 'favourite things' list, "I'm most excited just to see my friends again." Taking part in Camp Connected last year filled that gap, but as we all know – it just isn't the same as being with your favourite people face to face. This summer Jana hopes to reconnect with her camper friends and take part in the activities she enjoys the most – crafting, socializing, and you guessed it, dancing!

We are just as excited as Jana to invite campers back to in-person Camp Easter Seal programming this summer!

Camp is a very special place that provides children, youth, and adults experiencing disability the opportunity to socialize with their peers, enhance communications skills, and increase their self-esteem.
