
The Governance and Nominating Committee is chaired by Tom Spence and includes Bonnie Cherewyk, Stan Lautsch, Bill Schwarz, and Jonathan Tremblay. The Governance and Nominating Committee met in December 2022 and January 2023 to consider the slate of nominees to the Board.
