

Where is Camp Easter Seal located?

Camp is located at Manitou Beach near Watrous, Saskatchewan.

When do applications open?

Camp Applications open each year on February 1st and remain open until camps are full. To access the application site [CLICK HERE](#).

Arrival at Camp

Your arrival time will be sent to you with your Camper Acceptance Package.

Upon arrival at camp you will be greeted by Camp Easter Seal Staff. We will help you to carry your luggage and check in your camper.

We ask that you stay in our vehicle in the line until you reach the main chalet. This is for camper and staff safety as we do check in one camper at a time and our parking is limited.

Visiting Camp

Parents and/or caregivers are recommended to visit camp only on arrival and departure days. Visitation during camp sessions is discouraged in order to prevent homesickness and disruption of camp routine. If a visit is necessary for any reason you can call the camp office and we would be happy to help you arrange a visit.

Members of the public are welcome to visit camp. To arrange a tour of camp please call the camp office and we would be happy to help you out.

My Camper requires assistance at camp. How do I get my attendant registered?

If a camper requires a full-time attendant due to the nature of their disability, we will gladly make accommodations to have them join us. Camp Easter Seal discourages parents and family members from filling the role of attendant at Camp. To have your attendant registered with your camper they can sign up as a Camp Volunteer [HERE](#).

Does my Camper need spending money at camp?

Yes, often campers will go on outings like ice cream trips, shopping trips, mini golf etc. or they will opt for a meal out or a pizza party in. We also operate a canteen at camp where campers can purchase snacks and drinks. We also sell camp t-shirts and other merchandise each year. It is recommended to send a minimum of \$30.00 to camp with your camper.

What should my Camper bring with them to camp?

To prevent items being lost at camp:

- **Label EVERYTHING** with your camper's name (including personal equipment)
- Do not send expensive or favorite items with campers where possible
- Make sure to fill out the packing list for your camper with as much detail as possible.
