Camp Easter Seal Facts:

- Only fully accessible, barrier free camping facility in Saskatchewan
- Provide therapeutic recreational programming for individuals experiencing disability
- Opened its doors in 1956
- Located at Village of Manitou Beach (about 1.5 hours from Saskatoon or 2 hours from Regina)
- Camp sessions run late May to August and organized by age and ability
- Campers are ages 6 to over 65 from across Saskatchewan

Working at Camp:

- Available to work from all shifts from May to August (around age 18). High school students can participate in our Counsellor in Training program
- Responsible for own travel to Camp. Many staff form carpool arrangements once training starts
- Reside at camp during each session, and required to leave site on days off
- Staff will experience shared living arrangements, limited cell and technology use, and up to 12 hour shift work
- Smoking, alcohol, drugs are strictly prohibited on all camp property
